6. Financial Report:

7. Proposed budget for FY 2021 – 2022:

- a. If no other expenses are incurred before the end of June the carryover will be \$18,455
- b. \$30,252 is budgeted for road repairs and road maintenance materials starting in July 2021.
- c. No contribution to the Dam Reserve fund will be made this year pending getting quotes for repair of the emergency drain gate.
 - d. The proposed budget was passed as presented. (Hodge/Taylor/Unanimous).

8. Reports

Roads -

- a. The road survey was not completed before the meeting. Individual board members will perform surveys and send reports to Joe Warren for compilation. Condition of stop signs should be included in the road condition survey. The residents present on the call volunteered to do a survey. Lee will get the survey form to them.
- b. There was some discussion of the suitability of "chip sealing" for Dorado Canyon repair. It turns out that this may not have been the proposed solution. Whatever the technique/material this repair is a very longshot financially so there is no urgency and discussion can continue over time.

Weed/Brush Abatement - Dorado Canyon was sprayed

Dam/Lakes – None of the lakes filled completely due to drought this year

Communications – One of the residents present suggested that the existence of the website should be communicated to Showcase residents better. Lee has committed to do this.
